NOTICE TO CONDUCT TEST ACCEPTANCE CERTIFICATE (TAC) ON MARINE WATER QUALITY MONITORING EQUIPMENT FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY MONITORING PROGRAMME

- 1. TAKE NOTE that the above campaign will be commenced on 16 May 2017.
- 2. Please to be informed that entire activity will be within the port limit and only be conducted at daylight (from 0600 hours to 1800 hours) with these following particulars:

- 5. <u>Vessel involved</u> shall alert nearby vessels coming close proximity during this activity and also be reminded that <u>vessel involved</u> are required to communicate/report with Mike Kilo continuously (before entering port limit, before start of activity, after finish of activity, before leaving port limit).
- 6. For any case of emergency, please refer to the Emergency Response Procedure. **Mike Kilo** must be informed immediately at channel 12.
